It is the responsibility of the principal designer to ensure that a health and safety file is prepared and revised for the project. The file is **only required for projects involving more than one contractor** and should only include information about the current project that is likely to be needed to ensure health and safety during any subsequent work (such as maintenance, cleaning, refurbishment or demolition).
